#### What are the minimum hardware specifications?

The platform will run on the following minimum hardware specifications and above. However, the faster your computer, the better the content will run.

We recommend the following minimum specifications:

Processor	1 GHz or faster
RAM	512MB or higher
Screen resolution	1024x768 monitor display size
Audio	16 bit audio; speakers or headphones are required
Video	16 bit graphics
Input devices	Keyboard and Mouse
Assistive technologies	Jaws 10 (for visually impaired users)

The GIC LMS is a web-based platform (http://www.gic-online.org/vle) and can be accessed using most popular web-browsers. However, its performance and usability may differ depending on the browser version being used.
